He also advises investors on market and regulatory due diligence assignments in Europe and the Middle East.

Mr. Barany's recent work has had a significant focus on the economic assessment of issues arising in the context of international arbitrations and commercial disputes in the energy sector, including matters before the ICC, ICSID, and SCC. His work in international arbitration includes the assessment and quantification of damages (including loss of profits), business valuation, and the economic assessment of regulatory frameworks in the context of disputes in regulated sectors (such as renewables support matters).

Prior to joining NERA, Mr. Barany worked as an Economic Analyst Trainee at the European Commission, where he published a paper on the subsidization of fossil fuels, which was later cited by the IMF. He has relied on this research in advising clients in the Middle East on tariff reform.
