Dr. Milev's enforcement work relates to assisting counsel representing clients in regulatory enforcement proceedings and government investigations. On numerous occasions, he has presented to various regulatory agencies and boards of directors. His work in antitrust has involved the analysis of markets, benchmark price fixing, and price manipulation. In class actions, he has analyzed and testified on class certification, loss causation, and damages. In commercial litigation, he has testified in merger-related disputes and opined on lost profits and valuation. Dr. Milev also advises and presents on issues relating to digital currencies, biometric information, and value losses due to cyber incidents and data privacy breaches.

Dr. Milev is a frequent speaker and subject matter expert at industry and academic conferences and at events providing CLE credit to attorneys. He coauthored the chapter on Covered Bonds in the 7th edition of the *Handbook of Mortgage-Backed Securities* published by Oxford University Press and edited by Frank Fabozzi.

Dr. Milev holds a PhD in economics from Yale University. His doctoral dissertation used artificial intelligence techniques to develop a machine learning system for the analysis of big datasets of stock price reactions to earnings announcements.
