In mass tort litigations, Ms. Claxton has forecasted claims relating to prospective mass tort litigation involving asbestos, silica, mixed dust, hardboard siding, all-terrain vehicles, and medical devices. She has also conducted analysis in regards to product liability litigation, including issues of diminution of value and class certification, as well as having analyzed USATF data to determine the relationship between manufacturer and distributor practices and guns used in crime. Ms. Claxton has also been the Associate Project Director on 11 public sector disparity studies, including studies for the States of Texas and Maryland.
