Dr. Ostermeijer was the Principle Economic Researcher in the Spatial and Transport Impacts of Automated Driving project during the completion of his PhD in Economics. He has been published in leading academic journals including the *Journal of Urban Economics*, *European Economic Review*, *Journal of Economic Geography*, and *Regional Science and Urban Economics*.
